

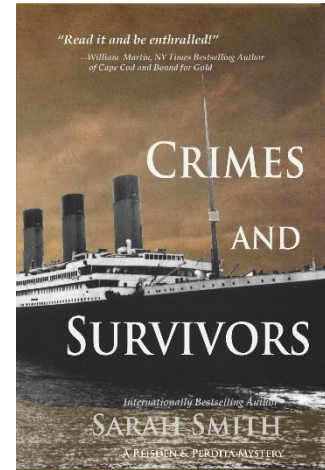
## ***Titanic Then, Titanic Now Goody Bag***

## **On board R·M·S·“TITANIC”**

Iced Iceberg Tea: White tea with 1 tsp dried mint per pot, or to taste; ice; sweeten to taste

Black Russian Tea: Black tea; per pot, 1 tbsp blackcurrant jam, juice of 2 lemons, or to taste

(“Emerald Russian” is with green tea)

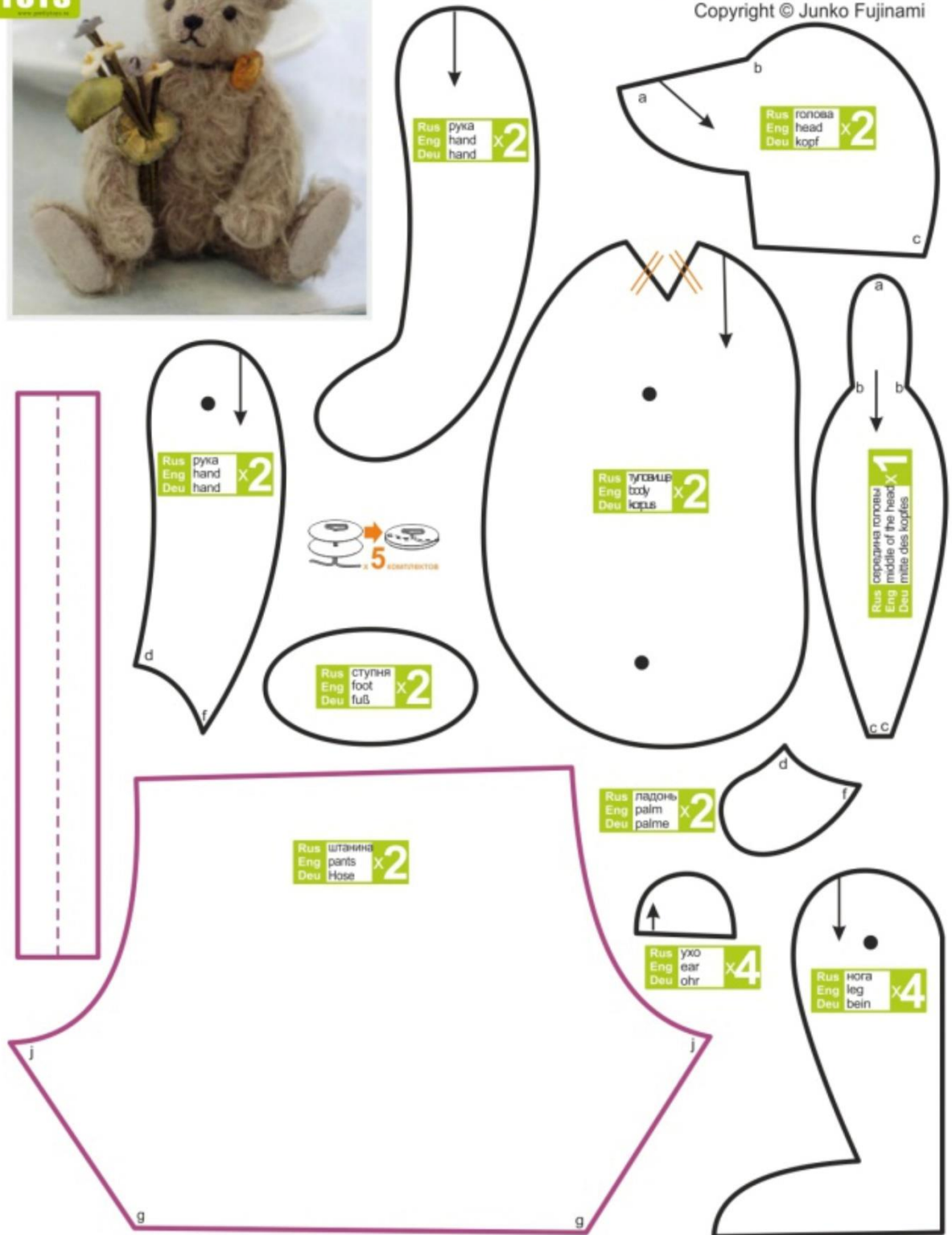
Captain Smith’s Tea: English Breakfast tea; per pot, 3-4 whole cloves, 1 cinnamon stick; add orange juice and honey to taste

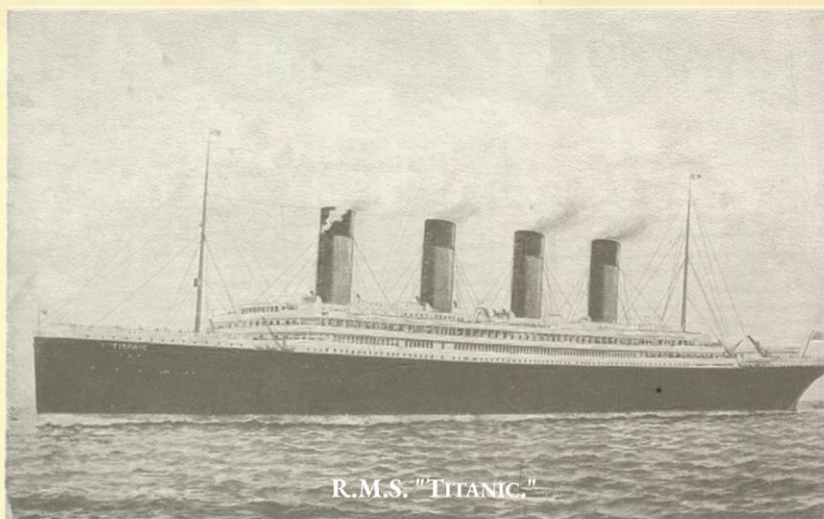

We survive.

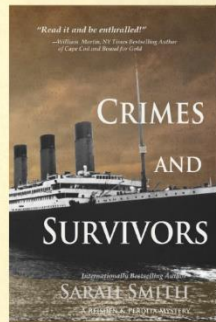
Some of us live with an iceberg.
